HC #01: Protect Sovereignty from World Health Organization Pandemic Treaty

A Resolution to Amend the Platform of the Georgia Green Party; and for other purposes.

A Resolution of the 2024 Additional Nominating Convention of the Georgia Green Party

Resolved, that the Platform of the Georgia Green Party is amended, by renumbering the enumerated planks to accommodate adding to the chapter on *Health Care*, a new plank 1., to read:

1. Protect Sovereignty of Nation from Capture of Public Health Policy by World Health Organization

The World Health Organization is currently negotiating two documents expected to be put to a vote at its meeting in May 2024. Observers are raising significant concerns with anti-democratic provisions of both the International Health Regulations and the Pandemic Treaty, sometimes called an Accord, Agreement or Instrument. Either document, if adopted, is expected to allow the WHO to impose public health policies on jurisdictions around the world over the objections of sovereign nations. As Greens we support adoption of S.444 / HR 1425 -- No WHO Pandemic Preparedness Treaty Without Senate Approval Act, requiring that the product of the WHO's work be deemed a treaty and 'be subject to Senate ratification' as an insufficient but necessary safeguard against anti-democratic measures being discussed in these negotiations.
